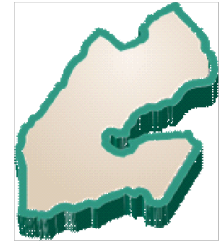

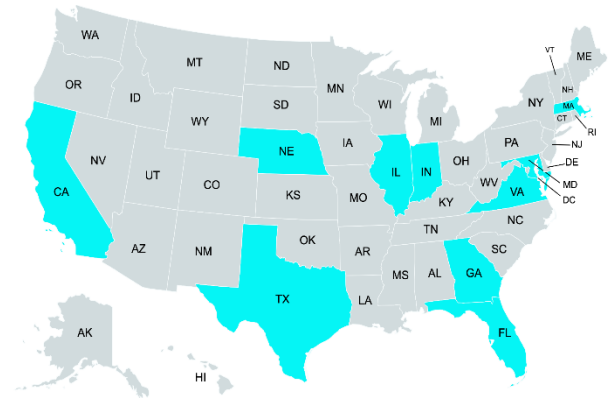


2022 Ranking: 16th Largest Export Market in MENA for U.S. Goods

Djibouti is eligible for U.S. trade benefits under the African Growth and Opportunities Act of 2000, which extends preferential access for imports from beneficiary Sub-Saharan African countries until June 2025. In 2022 there was a 3% decrease in exports from U.S. states to Djibouti since 2021. Djibouti's top imported sectors were Agricultural Products, Food & Kindred Products, Beverages & Tobacco Products, Textiles & Fabrics.

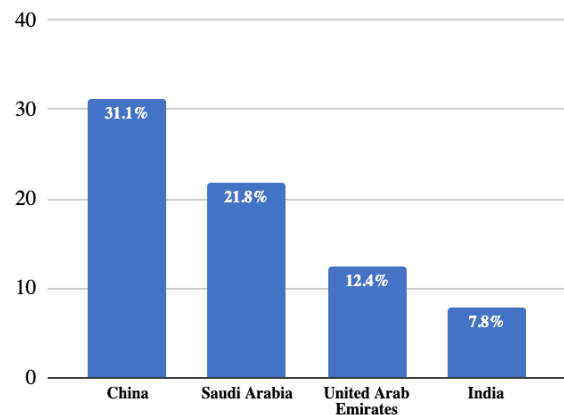
