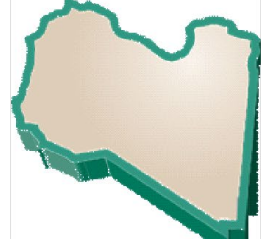




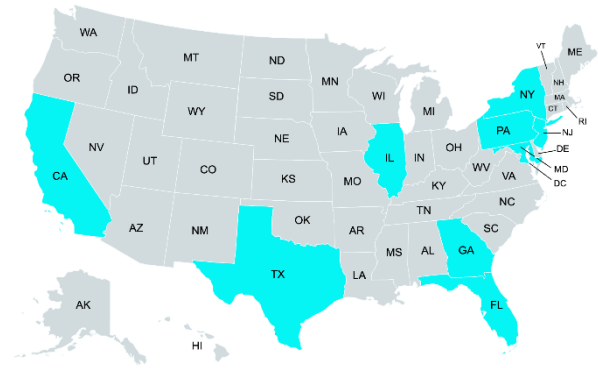
Libya

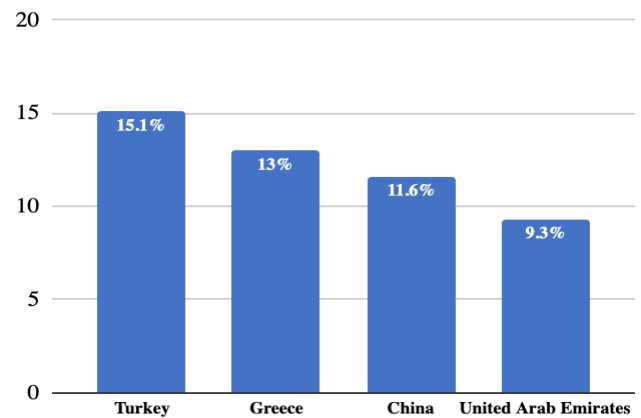
